Some of the key improvements include:


- Brand-new carpet for a sleek and inviting atmosphere

Workers Connect

2KG CHALLENGE

Workers Lifestyle Group support for reducing the incidence of diabetes in Blacktown through the 2kg Challenge has reached a new level during summer.

The basis behind the 2kg Challenge is driven by the fact that if someone is at risk of developing diabetes and loses just 2kg in weight, 30% of people will not go on to develop the condition. In addition, just a small and sustained weight loss reduces the risk of developing chronic diseases such as diabetes, heart disease and some cancers in addition to lowering blood pressure, cholesterol and blood sugar levels. WLG has collaborated with Western Sydney Diabetes, Novo Nordisk and WentWest to form a partnership aimed at education, detection and prevention of diabetes in our community.

After initially launching the online program in 2024 to our members and receiving your feedback, the Challenge, has been refined and added to, and is now being promoted to the wider community. It is a free 8 week program where the participant receives specific personalised information, material and support throughout their journey.




INTERNATIONAL DIABETES DAY

This day was recognised with Workers Lifestyle Group working with our partners in Western Sydney Changing Diabetes to conduct a screening day at Blacktown City Council. This corresponded with one of their staff meetings and enabled the team to screen over 25% of all the 200 attendees, starting with the Mayor, Brad Bunting.

Our collaboration between Novo Nordisk and Western Sydney Diabetes, Western Sydney Changing Diabetes, received Australia wide recognition by Novo Nordisk taking out the prestigious Prime award for the Best Public Health Initiative. The PRIME Awards recognise and celebrate excellence across 18 categories within healthcare communications and the Australian pharmaceutical and life sciences industry. The Best Public Health Initiative was hotly contested with several well known initiatives being fellow contenders, which made the win even more of an honour.

A large detection program has been conducted in Westpoint Blacktown using the staff and nurses from Western Sydney Diabetes. Situated near Woolworths, the group was able to test over 500 people during 4 days in January. Using a fingerprick test, the participant received their blood glucose results in 3 minutes. This test shows the glucose level for the last 3 months and is considered an effective way of detecting abnormal levels.

Each participant received an explanation of what their results meant and what action they should take, including seeing their GP if their results indicated them being at risk of, or having diabetes. In addition, each person received a range of information on local facilities and resources that would enable them to incorporate healthier habits into their everyday lives. This also included information on how to enroll in the 2kg Challenge. This method has been shown to be most effective in creating behaviour change. On follow up, over 65% of participants said that they had taken positive action as a result of having their blood test.

KEEPING THE KIDS SAFE

Young children are among the most vulnerable on our roads, and ensuring they have a properly fitted car seat is one of the best ways to protect them reducing the risk of injury by up to 70%. However, correctly installing a child car seat can be tricky.

That's why Kidsafe, with the support of Transurban, provides an incredible community service by offering free car seat safety checks. Workers Lifestyle Group was proud to host this initiative in our multilevel car park, giving local families and staff peace of mind.

The Kidsafe team had a huge day, assisting the community and ensuring little passengers were safely secured. By the end of the day, they had checked and adjusted over 100 car seats, a fantastic effort towards making our roads safer.

A big thank you to Kidsafe and Transurban for their dedication to child safety.

PINK UP BLACKTOWN


Workers Lifestyle Group is delighted to be involved in supporting the McGrath Foundation through being one of the organisers of Pink Up Blacktown. This initiative is being led by Councillor Julie Griffiths AM who has garnered support from a number of community organisations and leaders to run this campaign for 6 months in Blacktown. The objective is to raise funds to enable additional breast care nurses to be employed in Blacktown. With our large and rapidly growing population, these nurses are under represented and at least another 2 are required to have parity with other LGA's.

The first event was a High Tea which was held at the Blacktown City Council premises and attended by over 100 supporters. As well as a lavish high tea full of goodies, the attendees were delighted to hear presentations from the current Blacktown Breast Care nurses and were fascinated to learn about what their invaluable work involves. We were also very fortunate to have a presentation from Gai Hawthorn OAM Forrester who has successfully run Pink Up Penrith and had inspiring stories and advice to share with the audience.

This is a very exciting project and Workers Lifestyle Group is looking forward to continuing our support for this worthwhile cause.

CAREVAN

Carevan Blacktown, was founded in 2011 to assist and serve the community's most vulnerable members, extending a helping hand to people experiencing social and financial disadvantage and hardship of all kind.

Comprised of a group of dedicated volunteers, Carevan Blacktown provides a weekly communal meal service in Lalor Park, engaging the care and generosity of the community, and passing this on to those most in need. Patrons are welcomed without question, cost or criteria. Other support is available including food delivery, clothing and medical services.

Carevan Blacktown enables connection to others in their community, those who share the same difficulties, helping to provide support through the common experience. Breaking down loneliness and isolation, principal factors in disadvantage of all types, is an important focus of the work of Carevan Blacktown.

Workers Lifestyle Group is a strong supporter of Carevan. Most recently we worked as volunteers at the Carevan Christmas Party. This party is attended by over 350 local individuals, families and supporters. Attendees were treated to a delicious hot traditional Christmas dinner, followed by take home hampers and a visit from Santa with gifts for the children. Carevan reported that for many of the attendees, this would be their only Christmas celebration, so the emphasis was on fun and joy.

WLG was pleased to be able to provide additional support to the Christmas party by supplying soft drinks for the attendees. Staff from WLG were happy to be responsible for packing, delivering and unloading the soft drinks which were gratefully received by the Carevan volunteers and guests.


16 Days of Activism against Violence towards Women

Workers Lifestyle Group has been involved in several local events related this program which commenced on 25th November. The first event, Knit Bomb, was arranged by Blacktown City Council to bring the community together to acknowledge the prevalence and impact of DV on our community and work together to eliminate this societal problem.

Key community leaders from the Government, community, corrective services, police and relevant grass roots organisations listened to speeches and were involved in a ribbon tying event. Knitting and crocheted pieces produced by a community group were used to decorate trees and other structures around the Village Green. Sculptures produced by the inmates of Parklea prison were decorated in colourful knitted items and will be left in the area over the 16 days.

FOODBANK

Workers Lifestyle Group continues to provide support for the fantastic work conducted by Foodbank. During Summer, we were delighted to be invited to their Hunger Report Breakfast to learn about their recent research into the state of hunger in Australia. Results showed that hunger is particularly prevalent in certain areas, including Blacktown and amongst particular households and demographics, all of which are highly represented in our local area.

This, combined with a recent visit to their warehouse where a huge amount of food is stored and continuously shipped out, made it an easy decision to increase our support for their work. To this end, Workers Lifestyle Group has decided to provide additional funding to enable a weekend breakfast program to be set up for children at local schools. This will allow children to take home a food pack for Saturdays and Sundays.

We have also committed to providing volunteer support for Foodbank with our staff being encouraged to work in the warehouse at least one day per quarter during 2025.

THE BETTER FOUNDATION

The Better Foundation was created in 2016 to support Blacktown and Mount Druitt Hospitals. Blacktown and Mount Druitt Hospitals (BMDH) are administered as a single hospital on two sites. It is one of the largest hospitals in Australia. Every day brings new challenges at BMDH. Every day, hundreds of residents from the Blacktown and Mount Druitt local community attend the hospital for life-saving treatment. For this reason, WLG is proud to be a supporter of the Better Foundation. Through this ongoing support, several pieces of vital equipment have been purchased for the hospital.

The CEO of the Better Foundation, Kerry Powers, arranged for our CEO and Board to visit the hospital and meet with the General Manager, Brad Ceely along with specialists in the diabetes, cardiology and pediatric departments to view the equipment that Workers Lifestyle Group had helped to fund. On learning of the value that our previous contribution to the pediatric department has made, it has been decided that WLG will fund more milk warming equipment to help the staff, mothers and babies.


