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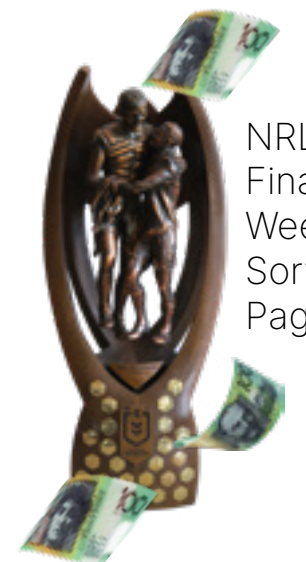
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President's Report

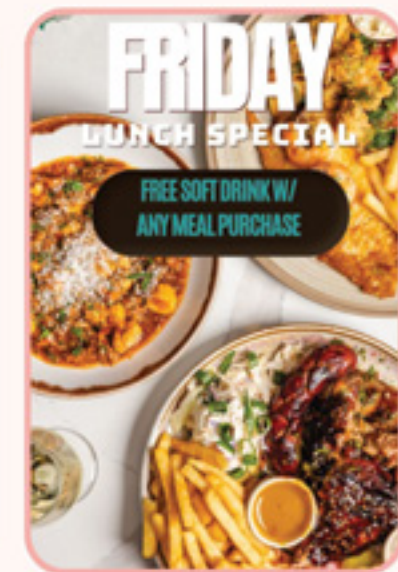
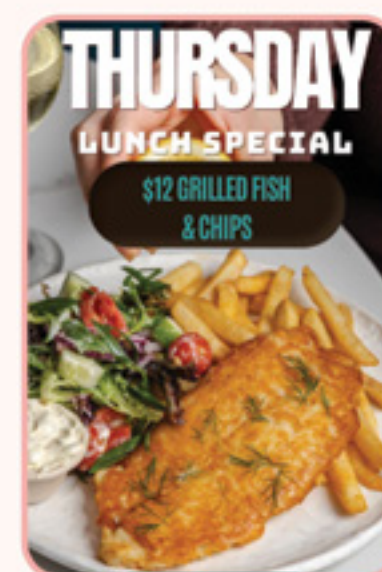

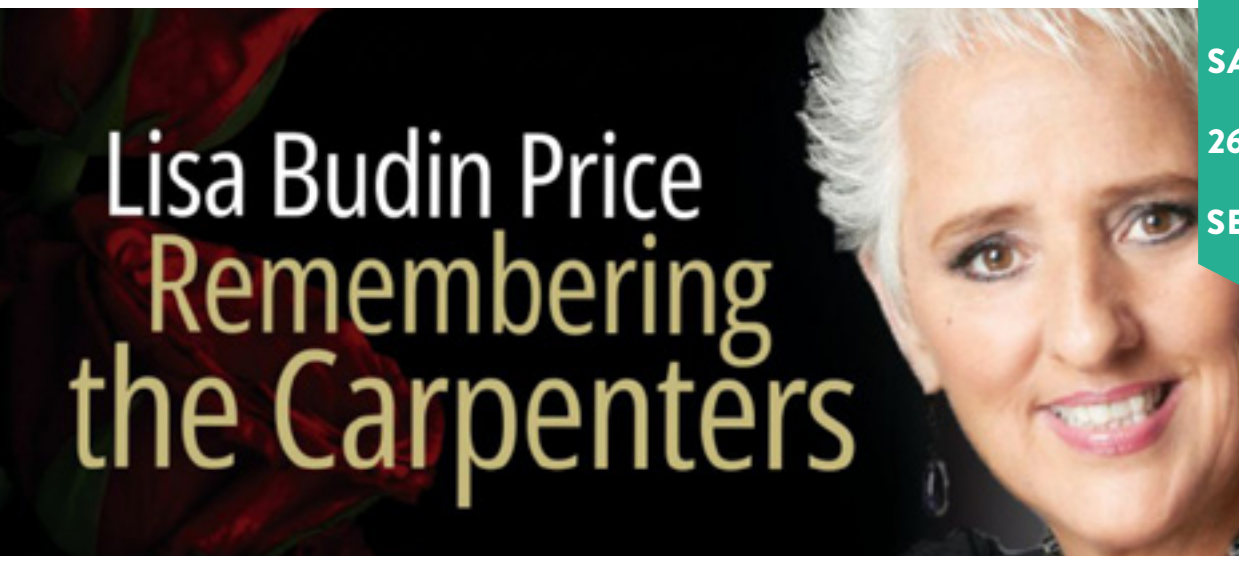

History Made

A Proud Moment for Blacktown Workers SFC



There are moments in sport that transcend the final whistle. Moments that become part of a club's story, defining who we are and inspiring where we are going. Last week, Blacktown Workers SFC experienced one of those moments.

On behalf of Matt Brown and the Blacktown Workers SFC Committee, we are proud to share a milestone achievement in the history of Blacktown Workers SFC.

Our Elite Football Program has etched its name into the record books by claiming the inaugural Men's Blacktown Cup title, a historic accomplishment that underscores the program's remarkable growth and success.

While lifting the trophy was a special moment, the journey to get there is what makes this achievement truly meaningful.

This success has not happened overnight. It is the culmination of years of hard work, strategic planning, dedicated recruitment, player development, and an unwavering commitment from our Executive Committee and Elite Football coaching staff. Countless hours have been invested behind the scenes by people who share a common belief in what Blacktown Workers SFC can achieve both on and off the field.

Reflecting on the achievement, Matt Brown said the Blacktown Cup victory is as much a celebration of community as it is of football.

"The players and coaches deserve enormous credit for what they've achieved, but this success has been made possible through the belief and support of so many people behind the scenes. From The Workers Lifestyle Group to the management team and Board of Directors, their commitment to our vision has empowered the program to grow and

given our players every opportunity to succeed. This achievement belongs to everyone who has played a part in the journey."

Matt's words reflect the collective effort that has underpinned the Elite Football Program's rise. The continued investment, encouragement and belief shown by The Workers Club Group, management team and Board of Directors have helped create an environment where players can thrive, coaches can develop, and long-term success can be built for the future.

As proud as we are of this historic achievement, our journey is far from over.

The Blacktown Cup victory serves as motivation, not a finish line. Our sights are firmly set on finals football in 2026, with all of our Elite teams continuing to push for success. The Under 21s, led by Coach Mariano Torisi and Manager Jason Notley, have shown tremendous promise throughout the season. Meanwhile, our Reserve Grade and First Grade squads, under the

leadership of Coaches Jason Charles and Paul Cucinotta, alongside Manager Ben Holzapfel, remain strongly in contention for their respective Grand Finals this year.

What has been achieved so far is a reflection of the culture being built throughout the club, one founded on commitment, professionalism, teamwork, and pride in representing the Blacktown Workers badge.

To our players, coaches, volunteers, supporters, sponsors, and everyone connected to Blacktown Workers SFC, thank you for being part of this journey. Together, we have celebrated a historic chapter in our club's story, but the most exciting chapters are still to be written.

History has been made. The future is bright. And with our players, coaches, volunteers and supporters united behind a shared vision, Blacktown Workers SFC continues to rise.



ClubGRANTS

Investing in Community, Changing Lives



For generations, The Workers Club Group has proudly stood as a leader in the Blacktown community, supporting the people, families and organisations that make our region stronger.

Through the 2026 ClubGRANTS Program, that commitment continues, with more than \$306,700 distributed to local charities, support services and community initiatives that are creating real and lasting impact across Western Sydney.

This year's funding will help deliver vital services in health, youth development, family support, mental health, domestic violence response, food security and social inclusion. Behind every grant is a shared goal: building a healthier, more connected and resilient community.

Making a Difference Where It Matters Most

Among this year's recipients, several organisations received significant funding allocations in recognition of the vital services they provide to our community.

Youth Off The Streets

Funding: \$30,000

Youth Off The Streets received funding for its First Nations Youth Support Project, a program dedicated to supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people across Blacktown. Through mentoring, education, cultural connection and practical support, the initiative helps young people build confidence, strengthen their sense of belonging and create positive pathways for the future. By investing in the next generation, Youth Off The Streets is helping to create stronger outcomes for young people, their families and the broader community.

Better Foundation

Funding: \$34,063.92

The Better Foundation received funding for its Keeping Families Together program, which provides home-based jaundice treatment for newborn babies. This innovative service allows babies who require treatment to remain at home with their families rather than spending extended periods in hospital. The result is reduced stress for parents, improved family bonding and a more comfortable recovery experience for newborns.

Foodbank NSW and Youth Off The Streets

Funding: \$30,000

Foodbank NSW will provide 900 school holiday food hampers to children and families experiencing financial hardship throughout Blacktown and surrounding suburbs. For many families, school holidays can place additional pressure on household budgets, making this support a vital lifeline.

Building Stronger Communities Together

While these organisations received the largest grants, every ClubGRANTS recipient plays an important role in improving the lives of local residents. From mentoring young men through the Top Blokes Foundation, supporting women experiencing domestic violence through the Harman Foundation, helping cancer patients regain confidence through Look Good Feel Better, delivering mental health and suicide prevention training through Walk It Off Australia, and reducing isolation among seniors

through local community programs, each initiative contributes to a stronger and more inclusive community.

The Workers Club Group understands that great clubs do more than provide entertainment and hospitality. They serve as community partners, investing directly into the people and organisations that make a difference every day. This philosophy has guided our organisation for many years and remains at the heart of everything we do.

As we celebrate another successful ClubGRANTS round, we thank every recipient organisation for the extraordinary work they do each day. Their dedication strengthens lives, supports families and creates opportunities for people across our region. Together, we are building a stronger, more connected community and ensuring Western Sydney continues to thrive for generations to come.

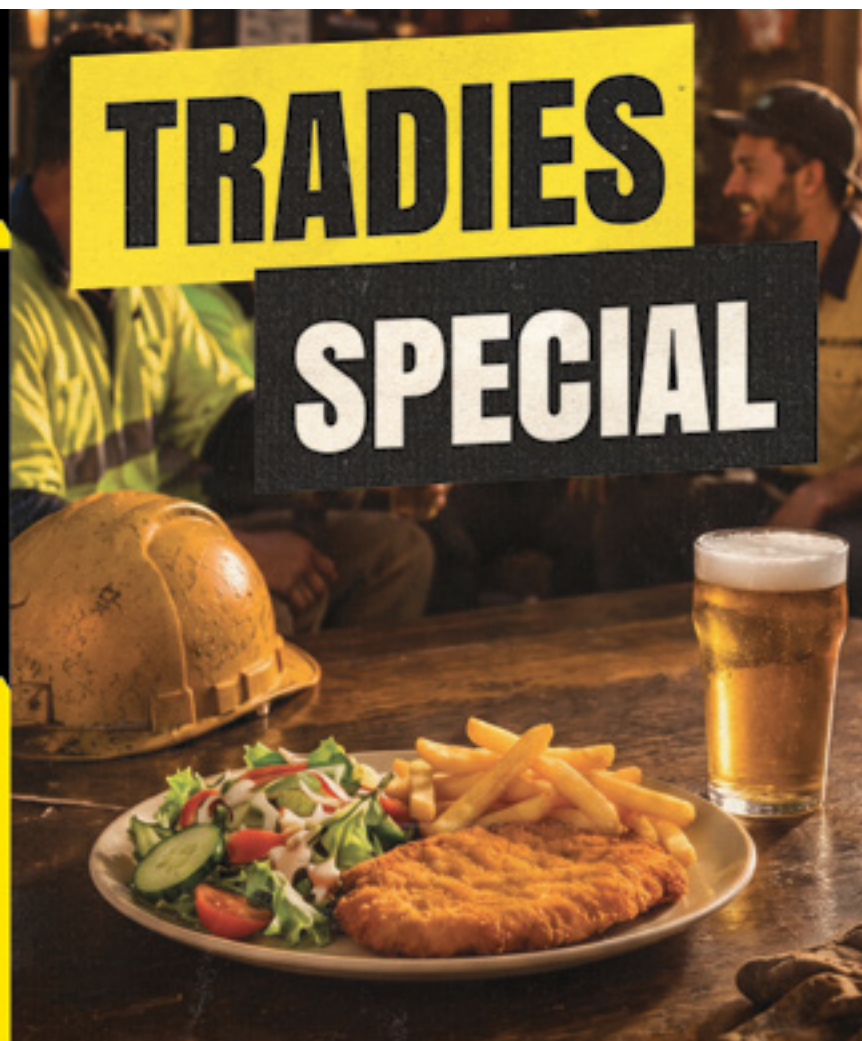

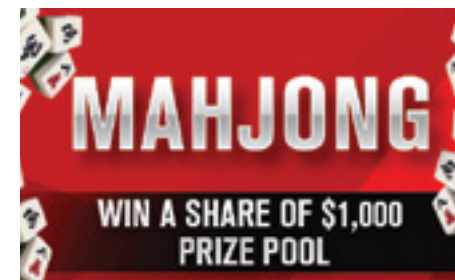
